Online Self-Paced Study Courses:

To Register for In-Person Recertification Workshops

Register online z.umn.edu/psee and pay the workshop fees.

- Superworkshop category selection: you can select the categories you want to attend during registration. Not all category combinations can be completed in one workshop since some category sessions run at the same time. You can only attend one morning session and one afternoon session. All participants must attend the General session.
- Field Day Workshops- detailed instructions and site maps will be emailed to participants a week before the event. These events will be offered rain or shine and will be primarily outdoors; plan accordingly.

Notes on attendance

- MDA manages the attendance for events. Bring your applicator license and photo ID.
- You must scan and check in and out with MDA as directed. You must be present and active in the meeting room unless it is a break time and stay until dismissal time to receive credit.
- Participation is required by all attendees. Cell phones must be put away during the meeting.
- Lunch, snacks and drinks will be offered at all in-person events. If you have a dietary need, please include that information on the registration and we will do our best to accommodate.

Pesticide Applicator Licensing Information


The Minnesota Department of Agriculture (MDA) issues and manages licenses for Commercial and Noncommercial Pesticide Applicators. The MDA administers closed-book and proctored exams as part of the licensing process. The initial exam measures competency in specific use categories and determines if the person is eligible for a pesticide applicators license.
