Special Meeting Regarding the Buffer Law

Commissioner Miller called the meeting to order with Commissioners Sharon Bring, Gary Kiesow, Rolland Miller, LeRoy Vonasek, and Auditor/Treasurer Scott Peters present. Other persons attending included County representatives from Kittson, Polk, Norman, Red Lake, Pennington and Roseau Counties consisting of Commissioners, Administrators, Auditors, Treasurers, SWCD personnel, TRF Times reporter, watershed representatives, and AMC and BWSR personnel, totaling 37 persons in all.

Scott Peters led the meeting and asked for input from each County, BWSR, and individuals regarding concerns and views they have regarding the current Buffer Law, what steps counties have taken to express opposition and what steps may be possible for this area of the state to take together as a group. Although no specific resolutions were brought forth from the group, the consensus was that each county did have concerns with the current buffer law and would like to see changes and enhancements with funding to pay for the required buffers and enforcement. John Jaschke from BWSR did indicate that he will take the concerns he had heard to see what possible remedies could be obtained.
